

Un-Purled Cables Hat

This hat is a companion piece to the Un-Purled Cables cowl designed by Sara Marie Rink. The cowl pattern is available as a free Ravelry download (<http://www.ravelry.com/patterns/library/un-purled-cables>) and must be used in order to knit the hat.



Size: Adult

Materials:

Queensland Collection Uruguay Chunky – 2 balls (73 yds / ball)*

(2) Size US11 circular needles, any length**

(1) Cable needle

Tapestry needle

*Original cowl pattern calls for Malabrigo Chunky, which can be substituted for the Uruguay Chunky, but an adjustment in needle size to obtain gauge—which is smaller than called for in the cowl pattern—may be needed. Only one skein of the Malabrigo will be needed.

**Pattern is written to be worked in the round on 2 circular needles, but DPNs can be substituted.

Gauge: 13 sts = 4”

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on as for the Un-Purled Cables cowl. Knit from the pattern as follows:

- Knit rounds 1-14
- Repeat rounds 7-14 twice (2x)
- Repeat round 7

Start Decreases

- Round 1: K1, *(K2tog) x2, K8, repeat from * to last 11 sts, (K2tog) x2, K7
- Round 2-3: Knit
- Round 4: *K4, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round
- Round 5-6: Knit
- Round 7: *K3, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round
- Round 8: Knit
- Round 9-10: Repeat rounds 7-8
- Round 11: *K2, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round
- Round 12: Knit
- Round 13: *K1, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round
- Round 14: Knit
- Round 15: K2tog all around



Cut yarn and thread tail through remaining sts. Pull tight and tie off. Bind in ends.

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
